Any player in 3rd through 12th grade who does not have a current USCF membership **will be given a one year membership** as part of the registration fee. Players 2nd grade and younger **will be given a USCF ID number**.

Mailed entries need to include name, address, grade, date of birth, school, and US Chess ID number (if any). It has to be received by February 1.

Rules and Format:

Five round tournament. No eliminations, everyone plays all rounds. All games are G/30, D/5. Team pairings avoided when possible, except last round.

Byes: If you are unable to play a round, you may request a **half point bye**.

Up to two **half-point** byes may be taken, if requested before beginning of First round.

First round starts at 9 AM

Please check in by 8:30 AM. Be at your table ready to play by 8:45 AM.

Prizes:

Trophies for 1st to 3rd place per grade.

Medals will be awarded for players who do not win a trophy.

The top three school teams will receive trophies. Team will consist of the top four players from each school. Players will represent the school they attend.
