6-Round Swiss – FOUR Sections:
Open, U1700, U1100, U600

Entry Fee: **Open and U1700:** \$25 if registered and **paid** by Monday, August 14th (by mail/postmarked), or Thursday, August 17th (at www.utahchess.com), \$35 late/onsite; **U1100 and U600:** \$15 if registered and **paid** by Monday, August 14th (by mail/postmarked), or Thursday, August 17th (at www.utahchess.com), \$25 late/onsite.

Unrated players play free but must have/purchase a US Chess membership.

Advance Registration: Option 1: Register online via link at utahchess.com. **Option 2** (by mail): Please send information and fees to Utah Chess Association PO Box 526049, Salt Lake City UT 84152. Include name, USCF ID# and **regular** rating, and section. Make checks payable to the order of **UCA**.

Onsite Registration: From **8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.** Players who have not pre-registered **and** pre-paid prior to 8:30 a.m. will be given one (1) half-point bye for the first round and paired starting in round two.

Prizes (b/15 paid entries per section, 80% guaranteed): Cash awards will be shared equally in case of tied placements.

Open: \$100-75, U1900 \$50-25, plus \$100 extra for anyone that can go 6/6 in this section.

U1700: \$75-50, U1400 \$40-20, U1200 \$20, plus \$50 extra for anyone that can go 6/6 in this section.

U1100: \$60-40, U800 \$30-20.

U600: \$40-30-20-15-10-10 and participation prize for all finishers.

Bobby Fischer Quiz: There will be a quiz about the life and times of Bobby Fischer. Cash prizes of \$40 first and \$20 second to the highest adult quiz scores, and \$20 first and \$10 second to the highest junior (under age 18) quiz scores. All tournament players are eligible to take the quiz and receive prizes. Non-tournament participants may take the quiz but are not eligible for prizes.

Schedule:

Open and U1700: 9:30 a.m., 12:15 p.m., 3:00 p.m. SATURDAY AND SUNDAY

* - Note: For Open and U1700 section, except for rounds 1 and 4, each round will be paired as soon as possible after the start previous round has finished. If both players agree, games in those rounds may start before the scheduled round time, *i.e.*, if your opponent agrees, you may your game as soon as the pairings have been posted even though it may be before the official round time. Otherwise, you must wait until the scheduled round times noted above to start the clock.

U1100 and U600 (Saturday Only): **Round One** will start promptly at **9:00 a.m.** Following rounds will be paired immediately upon completion of previous round. These rounds will begin immediately after pairings have been posted. There will be a lunch break.

Sections may be combined if there are not enough players.

Byes: Half-point byes – Players may request half-point byes for up to three (3) rounds but such byes must be requested prior to pairing of Rd 2. Last round bye requests are irrevocable. (See USCF Rule 22C.)

Time Control: **Open and U1700 Sections**, all rounds G/72 d5.
U1100 and U600 Sections, all rounds are G/30 d5.

If a player has a claim to two (or more) prizes (excluding Quiz prizes), cash prizes shall be awarded in accordance with USCF Rule 32B.

Players are responsible for supplying equipment (pieces, board and clock) and for knowing how to set clocks. (USCF Rule 16B)
