**Date:** Saturday, 9 March

**Time:** First round 10:00 am. *9:30--9:45 on-site registration for any failing to register on-line.*

**Location:** Wilkinson Center (1060 E Campus Dr, Provo), top floor, on BYU campus.

**Time Control:** Clocks are to be set at 60 minutes per player (G/60) plus a 5 second Fischer time increment.

**Round times:** 10 am, 1 pm, ~3 pm

**Trophies/plaques:** Following the tournament at approximately 5 pm, trophies will be awarded to the top three teams. Individual plaques will be given to the top player on board 1, 2 and 3. For the reserve section, first and second place trophies will be awarded.

**Eligibility:** If you are currently taking classes at a college or university (or have taken at least one since last year's tournament) then you're good to compete individually or on a team.<sup>i</sup>

<sup>i</sup> Universities, colleges, trade schools, business schools, military academies, barber schools and other vocational schools all qualify, so long as the student has graduated from high school. Therefore, High School students taking college classes are not eligible until they graduate.
