This tournament is open to all girls, grades Pre-K through 12, living in Utah
Three Sections:

- **K12 Open.** All grades can play in this section. **Grades 6-12 must play in this section.** The winner of this section is the *2023 Utah Girls Champion*. The winner can represent the state of Utah at the [WIM Ruth Haring National Tournament of Girls State Championship](#) (formerly the National Girls Invitational Tournament).
- **Grades 3 to 5**
- **Grades Pre-K to 2**

Schedule and Format: 5 Round Swiss. No elimination, all players play all rounds.

First round for the **Open Section starts at 9:30am**, the rest starts at **10am**. Other rounds to follow as soon as possible thereafter. Team pairings avoided except as needed to determine a clear champion (nominees) in the Open section (TD discretion). **No lunch break scheduled.**

Time Control: All rounds are **G/30, d/5**, except **G/45, d/5 for round 4 and 5 in the Open Section** (subject to change accordingly)

Prizes: Top 5 overall (Open Section only) and grade level trophies will be awarded.

Participation prizes will be awarded to all other players.

Byes: Half point byes – Up to two half point byes may be taken but must be requested before the beginning of Round 2.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 Pre-registration (Registration must be received by **Feb 17, 2023**).

\$25.00 On-Site Registration ends 15 minutes before the section starts (9:15am for Open; 9:45am for others)

US Chess Memberships: This is a US Chess Federation tournament. Players who are currently or have ever been members of US Chess need to provide their membership numbers when registering so that a duplicate player/number is not



created. Membership numbers and other information are available at uschess.org. *Any player who does not have a current US Chess membership for the event will be given a 1-year membership as part of her registration fee.*
